For these stops we will stay in more basic, authentic properties that are the best available for the location. Fine dining opportunities may be limited in these locales resulting in more buffet-style group meals due to service limitations. While these stops may require a more adventurous spirit, we believe you will be rewarded with deeply enriching and authentic experiences that can only be found off the beaten path.



March 11 - 12

Washington, D.C.

TUESDAY, MARCH II

Individual Arrivals in Washington, D.C.

Upon arrival at the Four Seasons Hotel Washington, D.C., please visit the *Chasing the Northern Lights* hospitality room. Please bring your passport with you. The check-in staff will collect your passport and return it to you the next morning at breakfast. You will also receive your name tag and other important updates.

March 12 - 14

QLake Mývatn, Iceland

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 12

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Akureyri. Please remember to stop at the TCS hospitality desk to collect your passport.

Depart: Washington, D.C. | 10:00 A.M. Arrive: Akureyri, Iceland | 8:40 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 6H 40M Meal Service: Lunch

Clear immigration and customs and transfer to the Aviation Museum in Akureyri for a private buffet dinner. Then, we will transfer one hour to the hotel in Lake Myvatn with photo stops for the Northern Lights if they are visible.

THURSDAY, MARCH 13

After breakfast at the hotel, depart for your full-day or morning sightseeing options.

Full-Day Touring

☐ Tour of Húsavík with Whale Watching

Transfer about 40 minutes to Húsavík, and begin with a guided visit to the Whale Museum, followed by a stroll around town to see the Swiss chalet-style Húsavík Wooden Church and explore the harbor. After enjoying local cuisine at Gamli Baukur for lunch, hop on a boat and go whale watching with the possibility of seeing other marine mammals.

■ Tour of Húsavík with Geobaths

Transfer about 40 minutes to Húsavík, and begin with a guided visit to the Whale Museum, followed by a stroll around town to see the Swiss chalet-style Húsavík Wooden Church and explore the harbor. After enjoying local cuisine at Gamli Baukur for lunch, soak in the relaxing geothermal baths while taking in the Icelandic scenery.

□ Lofthellir Cave Tour (Strenuous)

On this active adventure, led by an expert guide, crawl to enter the subterranean world of Lofthellir. Once inside, you will be able to stand fully to take in this mesmerizing labyrinth of ancient lava formations and ice sculptures formed from a volcanic eruption 3,500 years ago. Navigate through narrow passages and towering chambers, each revealing Iceland's rich geological history.

Morning Touring

☐ Highlights of Mývatn Lake

Take a journey around Lake Mývatn to visit its notable volcanic features. Begin by exploring Dimmuborgir, known as the Black Fortress, where lava hardened as rock to form many caves and caverns. Ascend the slopes of the Hverafjall tephra cone, offering panoramic views of the surrounding volcanic terrain. At Skútustaðir, witness the fascinating pseudo craters that dot the landscape, formed by steam explosions when lava flowed over wetlands. Continue onto Námaskarð, where you'll encounter a geothermal wonderland of hot springs, mud pots and steam vents.

Snowmobiling by Mývatn Lake

Across from our hotel, hop on a snowmobile and tour around Lake Mývatn. Helmets and warm overalls are provided, outer gloves are avilable, and warm attire is recommended. If you plan on driving the snowmobile, you must provide a driver's license.

Afternoon Touring

After lunch, guests who have selected a morning sightseeing selection may depart on your afternoon options:

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☐ Guided Horseback Ride

Drive 10 minutes from our hotel to the stables where we'll divide up into smaller groups based on experience to set out for a ride with a guide. Helmets will be provided, and it's recommended to wear warm layers.

After dinner, put on your layers for a chance to chase the Northern Lights.

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Ålesund.

Depart: Akureyri, Iceland | 11:00 A.M. Arrive: Ålesund, Norway | 2:15 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 2H 15M Meal Service: Lunch

After clearing Norwegian immigration and customs, transfer to the scenic Mount Aksla. Then, we drive to the city center where we embark on a city walking tour.

City Walking Tour

Experience the charm of Ålesund as you stroll through its picturesque streets, seeing the art nouveau architecture and vibrant harbor before continuing to our hotel for check-in.

Tonight, you will enjoy a sunset cocktail reception and dinner at the hotel restaurant. After dinner, choose to chase the Northern Lights.

THURSDAY, MARCH 15

Full-Day Touring

☐ Hjørundfjord Cruise

Transfer to the port for a cruise around the idyllic Hjørundfjord. The journey through its calm waters starts vast and narrows as we cruise further inward, surrounded by plunging mountains. To the west, we'll find small villages connected by a network of mountain roads. Once we cruise to Oye, you'll have your pick of activities—kayaking, snowshoeing, floating sauna and wine tasting.

Morning Touring

Cod Fishing

Embark on an adventure aboard a traditional fishing boat, led by an experienced skipper. March is the season for the spectacular Borgundfjord cod fisheries. Take part in an Ålesund tradition that offers breathtaking views of the city and mountains while catching some fish yourself.

☐ Kayak the Fjords

Few experiences can compete with the serenity of paddling the fjords, surrounded only by the sounds of your paddles breaking the surface. With experienced guides, get up close and personal with nature. Paddling at the foot of jagged mountain peaks, getting close to wildlife, stopping for a break in one of the many bays and inlets.

Afternoon Touring

□ Local Farm Tour

Meet a charming local couple who live in the fjord village of Glomset. They will show you how they preserve local food traditions through hunting, growing, baking and fishing everything they produce and serve at the farm. Learn about their cultural heritage and craftsmanship with a local food tasting for lunch.

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Cooking Class in the Boat House

Join a renowned chef for a food class in a charming boat house. During the course, explore the hotel's food philosophy and be introduced to Norwegian cooking traditions. Experience tastings of local produce and discover the flavors that make Norway unique.

All Guests

Gather to enjoy cocktails before a guest lecture followed by dinner. Then, decide to embark on an opportunity to see the Northern Lights.

March 16 - 19

PRovaniemi, Finland

SUNDAY, MARCH 16

After breakfast, transfer 45 minutes to the airport where you board the private jet and depart for Finland.

Depart: Ålesund, Norway | 11:00 A.M. Arrive: Rovaniemi, Finland | 1:45 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 1H 45M Meal Service: Lunch

Clear immigration and customs and transfer to the hotel or continue on your pre-chosen activity.

☐ Sleigh Ride & Reindeer Farm

A local reindeer herder and her best reindeer will greet us at the airport and take us on a sleigh ride. After getting kitted with winter gear, sit comfortably in sleds pulled by reindeer and travel through the snowy forest to a reindeer farm. At the reindeer farm, experience the legendary Arctic Circle Crossing Ceremony. Now your adventure in Lapland can begin!

☐ Snowmobiling & Husky Adventure

□ Ranua Wildlife Park

Set amidst stunning natural landscapes and the most northern zoo in the world, this wildlife sanctuary offers a unique opportunity to observe a variety of wildlife in their native habitats. Encounter birds of prey, arctic foxes, wolverines, wolves, lynx cats, musk oxen and roe deer, among others while exploring the park.

☐ Ice Fishing & Floating Excursion

A guide will lead you on a tranquil 45-minute forest walk using snowshoes and then give an exciting ice fishing demonstration along the way. Try your hand at cutting your own icefishing hole and spend about 30 minutes fishing in the serene surroundings. For the adventurous, try the experience of arctic ice floating, wearing a high-quality rescue suit to be protected from the icy waters. Let your body and mind float in the frozen experience. With your own clothing under the suit, you will stay warm even in the open zero-degree water.


