Explorer Destinations

Explorer destinations will be marked with the above icon. These destinations have been chosen due to their remote beauty, historical and cultural significance, unique touring and wildlife access rather than their luxury lodging and dining. For these stops we will stay in more basic, authentic properties that are the best available for the location. Fine dining opportunities may be limited in these locales resulting in more buffet-style group meals due to service limitations. While these stops may require a more adventurous spirit, we believe you will be rewarded with deeply enriching and authentic experiences that can only be found off the beaten path.



December 29 – 30

Miami, Florida

MONDAY, DECEMBER 29

Individual Arrivals in Miami, Florida

Upon arrival at the Four Seasons Hotel Miami, please visit the *Around the World* hospitality room. Please bring your passport and proof of Yellow Fever vaccination or waiver with you. The check-in staff will collect your passport and return it to you the next morning at breakfast. You will also receive your name tag and other important updates.

Further details about check-in will be provided in the welcome letter when you check in to the hotel.

December 30 – January 2

Cusco & Machu Picchu or 🧭 Pisco, Peru

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 30

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to Pisco. Please remember to stop at the TCS hospitality desk to collect your passport.

☐ Cusco and Machu Picchu Guests

After clearing Peruvian immigration and customs, we board our charter flight to Cusco. Flight time is approximately 1 hour. Arriving in Cusco, transfer to the hotel for check-in and dinner.

OVERNIGHT: Palacio Nazarenas, A Belmond Hotel

☐ Pisco Guests

Upon arrival in Pisco, clear Peruvian immigration and customs and then transfer to the hotel for check-in and dinner.

OVERNIGHT: Hotel Paracas

WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 31

☐ Cusco and Machu Picchu Guests

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the train station to board the Hiram Bingham luxury train for the three-hour trip to Aguas Calientes, known as the gateway to Machu Picchu. Sit back and savor the views of the scenic Urubamba Valley while you enjoy a late brunch on the train.

Or if you prefer, you may depart the hotel earlier to enjoy the Urubamba Valley by motor coach, with time to explore the village of Ollantaytambo before joining the group on the Hiram Bingham train.

Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes, board a motor coach for the final half-hour drive up to the Incan city, Machu Picchu, which was rediscovered by Hiram Bingham in 1911.

Explore Machu Picchu with visits to the watchtower, temples, houses, baths and the great “House of the Sun.” Enjoy afternoon tea at a local restaurant after a guided tour of the citadel.

Transfer back to the village of Aguas Calientes to catch the Hiram Bingham train for your return to Cusco. Dinner is served in the dining cars. From the station, we return to Cusco and our hotel by motor coach.

❑ Pisco Guests

After breakfast, take an approximately 90-minute flight to take in the fascinating Nazca Lines. Covering over 300 miles of desert hills and sands, some of the over 10,000 pre-Columbian geoglyphs stretch more than 5 miles long and 100 feet wide. The purpose of the Nazca Lines are not fully known, but some think they are religious offerings to the gods who would look down on them from the heavens or sacred pathways used during rituals.

Return to the hotel for lunch before enjoying a late afternoon dune experience. Depart on an adrenaline-filled ride on specially outfitted 4x4 trucks driven by expert drivers. Drive up and along the sandy dunes, and take in the spectacular scenery around you. Afterwards, conclude your outdoor adventure with a picnic of beverages and light snacks with the dunes as your unforgettable backdrop.

OVERNIGHT: Hotel Paracas

THURSDAY, JANUARY 1

❑ Cusco and Machu Picchu Guests

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, then you may choose between several morning sightseeing options.

Morning Touring

Sacsayhuaman and Plaza de Armas

Visit the ruins of Sacsayhuaman, a monumental fortress just outside of Cusco. It is believed that Cusco was laid out in the form of a puma, whose head was the hill of Sacsayhuaman. Return to Cusco and explore the Plaza de Armas, including the grand Cusco Cathedral.

San Pedro Market and Plaza de Armas

Visit the San Pedro Market, located about a ten minute walk from the Plaza de Armas to take in the lively energy of this hub of local life. Your senses will come alive as you sample local fruits and fresh juice and smell the spices and meat being sold throughout. You will also have a chance to shop for a variety of souvenirs. Afterward, enjoy time to explore the central plaza including the grand Cusco Cathedral.

Korikancha, Plaza de Armas and Cathedral

Explore the ruins of Korikancha, or Temple of the Sun, where the Convent of San Domingo now stands. This site was formerly the main Inca temple of Cusco, and was fabled for its gold-covered walls. Walk back to the Plaza de Armas to see the beautiful Cusco Cathedral. Afterward, enjoy time to shop in the central plaza on your own.

Afternoon Touring

Traditional Weaving Demonstration

Transfer to Chinchero where master Andean weaver, Nilda Callañaupa, and her community of weavers will give a special demonstration of traditional Andean weaving.

Sacsayhuaman and Plaza de Armas

Visit the ruins of Sacsayhuaman, a monumental fortress just outside of Cusco. It is believed that Cusco was laid out in the form of a puma, whose head was the hill of Sacsayhuaman. Return to Cusco and explore the Plaza de Armas, including the grand Cusco Cathedral.

All Guests

This evening, dine at your choice of local restaurant.

❑ Pisco Guests

Morning Touring

After breakfast at the hotel, depart by boat for a morning cruise around the Ballestas Islands, the most important wildlife sanctuary on the Peruvian coast. This group of small, rocky islands is home to an abundance of marine birds and mammals, including Humboldt penguins, blue-footed boobies, fur seals and sea lions.

Afternoon Touring

Return to the hotel for lunch before transferring to Hacienda La Caravedo, the oldest, continuously operating vineyard in the Americas. Here you enjoy a tasting of pisco, Peru's famed brandy distilled from grapes, followed by dinner and local entertainment.

This former 16th-century Carmelite convent has been renovated into Cusco's premier luxury hotel. The hotel is a blend of authentic historical décor and modern luxuries. The site includes an outdoor heated pool, on-site dining and a spa. This all-suite hotel features the original exposed stone walls, heated Peruvian marble bathrooms, Persian rugs and oxygenated rooms. All suites include a widescreen TV, as well as an iPod docking station and an iPad for guest use. 24-hour personal butler service is included in all suites.

Located on the coast and surrounded by the Paracas National Reserve, Hotel Paracas offers an outstanding location and upscale accommodations with ocean views. Enjoy two swimming pools, a bar-lounge, a luxury spa and fine dining. In addition, the Ballestas Islands ecological sanctuary is located just off shore in front of the hotel.



January 2 – 4

Easter Island, Chile

FRIDAY, JANUARY 2

☐ Cusco and Machu Picchu Guests

After breakfast at our hotel, transfer to the Cusco Airport for your charter flight back to Pisco. Flight time is approximately 1 hour, 10 minutes.

☐ Pisco Guests

After breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport where you will be reunited with the Cusco and Machu Picchu guests for your flight to Easter Island.

Depart: Lima, Peru | 10:10 A.M.

Arrive: Easter Island, Chile | 3:30 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 5H 20M

Meal Service: Lunch

After clearing Chilean immigration and customs, we will transfer to the hotel with a stop at Ahu Tahai, the site of three restored *moai*, the rock statues for which the island is famous. Once at the hotel, check-in and enjoy dinner at one of the on-site restaurants.

OVERNIGHT: Nayara Hangarao

SATURDAY, JANUARY 3

Morning Touring

After breakfast, embark on a full-day tour of the island.

We will begin at the Rano Raraku quarry, where almost 400 giant statues remain in various stages of completion, giving us insights to how these mysterious icons may have been created. At Ahu Tongariki, we visit a monument featuring 15 large statues lined in a row.

Afternoon Touring

After a barbecue lunch on the beach, continue to explore the island or spend the rest of your afternoon at leisure.

You may choose to visit Ahu Akivi, considered to be a particularly sacred site, and home to seven moai, all of which are positioned to face sunset during the spring equinox and have their backs to the sunrise during autumn equinox. The astronomical precision is unique to this location on the island.

Or, you may take a guided walk along the island's beautiful beaches, across semi-rugged terrain to see additional moai at Ovahe and La Perouse. At the foot of a volcanic cliff, these small beaches are less frequented and offer serene views of the Pacific Ocean.

ACCOMMODATION

NAYARA HANGAROA

The Nayara Hangaroa was designed in homage to the village of Orongo, a ceremonial place on Rapa Nui. Guest rooms are built of natural materials like cypress logs, clay and volcanic rock, immersing guests in the Rapa Nui habitat. Inspired by the shape of caves, the rooms are imbued with smooth, organic shapes. Rooms also feature a clay bath, a separate shower, a music system, a desk, a safe-deposit box, a mini-bar and a private terrace with an ocean view.



January 4 – 5

Papeete, Tahiti (Logistical Overnight Stop)

SUNDAY, JANUARY 4

Morning Touring in Easter Island

This morning, you may choose to rise early for a sunrise photo shoot at Ahu Tongariki. After breakfast, transfer to the airport, stopping at Ahu Akivi, considered to be a particularly sacred site, and home to seven moai, all of which are positioned to face sunset during the spring equinox and have their backs to the sunrise during autumn equinox. The astronomical precision is unique to this location on the island. Alternatively, you may choose to spend your morning at leisure and transfer directly to the airport.

Upon arrival at the airport, board the private jet for our flight to Tahiti.

Depart: Easter Island, Chile | 12:00 P.M.

Arrive: Papeete, Tahiti | 1:00 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 6H

Meal Service: Lunch

After check-in, remain at the hotel for some time at leisure, or depart on your choice of sightseeing activity.

Harbor Cruise

From the hotel dock, board a catamaran and set sail down the west coast of Tahiti. The catamaran offers plenty of shaded seating under the canopy and two large nets where you may soak in the sun and relax. Reach the south shores of Taapuna's passage, renowned for waves that attract local and international surfers, especially on swell days. Inside the lagoon, drop anchor and enjoy a dip and time to explore the clear waters. Masks and snorkels will be provided. You may also settle back in the catamaran deck and nets to unwind. Enjoy a local refreshment and a few other local specialties as you sail through turquoise waters all the way home. Bottled water and soft drinks will also be available. *Note: This activity is weather dependent.*

❑ Lagoon Cruise on Speed Boat

From the hotel dock, board a speed boat to reach Taapuna's passage, where local and international surfers can be spotted taking on the waves. Proceed to the ocean en route to Sapinus, where some of Tahiti's most picturesque waves crest along the reef's edge. Here you will have the opportunity to snorkel in the crystal waters and possibly spot resident turtles under the waves. Masks and snorkels will be provided. *Note: This activity is weather dependent.*

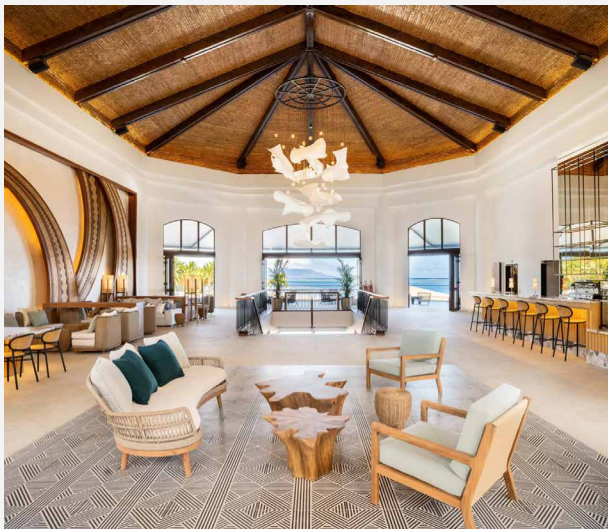
❑ Lagoon Cruise on Zodiac

From the hotel dock, board a Zodiac to reach Taapuna's passage, where local and international surfers can be spotted taking on the waves. Proceed to the ocean en route to Sapinus, where some of Tahiti's most picturesque waves crest along the reef's edge. Here you will have the opportunity to snorkel in the crystal waters and possibly spot resident turtles under the waves. Masks and snorkels will be provided. *Note: This activity is weather dependent.*

This evening, enjoy a cocktail reception with entertainment and dinner at leisure at the resort.

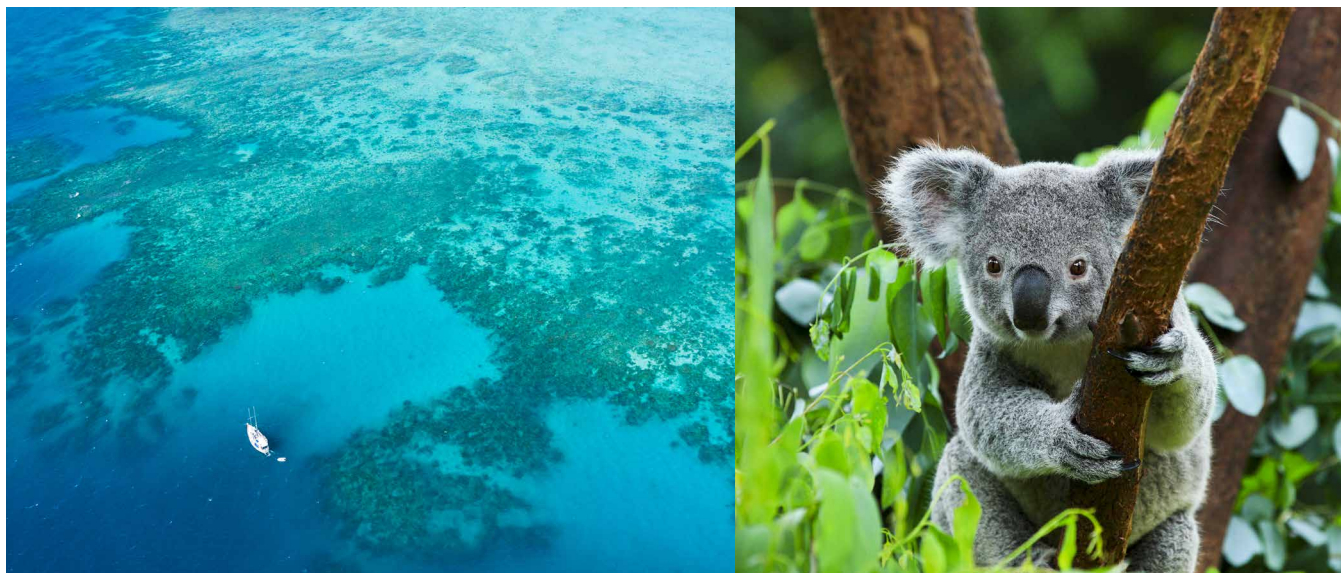

Clear Australian immigration and customs and transfer approximately one hour to the hotel in Port Douglas. Upon arrival, check in and enjoy a dine-around dinner at one of the hotel restaurants.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 7

Today, you may rise early for an optional yoga session at the hotel, or choose have a more leisurely paced morning. After breakfast, depart for full-day sightseeing options.

Full-Day Touring

☐ Reef Cruise - Snorkeling

Transfer by coach for the Port Douglas Marina for a cruise out to the Great Barrier Reef. A UNESCO World Heritage site, the Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest coral reef system, composed of roughly 3,000 individual reefs and 900 islands stretching for over 1,600 miles. The Great Barrier Reef is the world's biggest single structure made by living organisms.

Explore the reef, alongside the guests opting to dive, stopping first to visit a private pontoon where you can experience the vast coral ecosystem from a semi-submersible submarine. Then, head out into the open water where you can enjoy time for snorkeling amid the stunning variety of marine life. Lunch will be served onboard the boat. You return to shore this afternoon, where you may choose to shop in Port Douglas or transfer directly to the hotel.

❑ Reef Cruise - Certified Diving

Transfer by coach for the Port Douglas Marina for a cruise out to the Great Barrier Reef. A UNESCO World Heritage site, the Great Barrier Reef is the world's largest coral reef system, composed of roughly 3,000 individual reefs and 900 islands stretching for over 1,600 miles. The Great Barrier Reef is the world's biggest single structure made by living organisms.

Explore the reef, alongside the guests who are snorkeling, stopping at a private pontoon to view the vast coral ecosystem from a semi-submersible submarine. Then, head out into the open water to enjoy a time for diving amid the stunning variety of marine life. Please note that diving is subject to medical clearance by the diving staff and approval of guests' internationally recognized SCUBA certification card. Lunch will be served onboard the boat. We return to shore this afternoon, where you may choose to shop in Port Douglas or transfer directly to the hotel.

❑ Daintree Rainforest

Spend the day exploring the Daintree Rainforest. Start with a Dreamtime Walk through the Mossman Gorge with an Aboriginal guide of the Kuku Yalanji tribe. The gorge is a rainforest sanctuary of rare and exotic fruit trees and wildlife facing extinction. After the walk, discuss rainforest flora and fauna with your guide and learn more about traditional Aboriginal culture. Choose to shop in Port Douglas or return directly to the hotel.

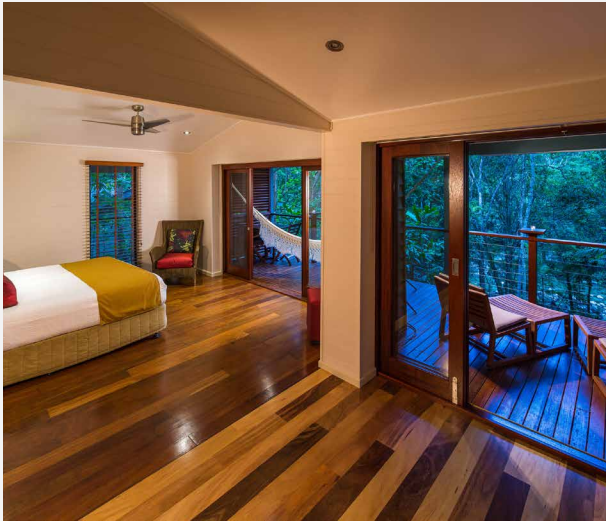
❑ Full-Day at Leisure

This morning, breakfast is at the hotel before you transfer to the airport for your flight to Cambodia. If you wish, you may stop at a rainforest habitat to learn more about Australia's endemic flora and fauna en route.

Arrive: Siem Reap, Cambodia | 3:45 P.M.

Elapsed Time: 7H 45M

Land in Siem Reap and clear Cambodian immigration and customs before transferring to the hotel for check-in.

This evening, enjoy an à la carte dinner at one of the hotel restaurants.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 9

Morning Touring

You have two options for your visit to Angkor Wat: an early morning sunrise visit, or a mid-morning tour.

Early Morning Angkor Wat

Wake up early before sunrise and transfer to Angkor Wat to explore this magnificent temple complex, also known as “the city which is a temple.” Angkor Wat is the world's largest religious structure built from stone. Enjoy breakfast before visiting Ta Prohm, which is known for the massive trees that have engulfed the temple walls over the centuries. You also visit the Elephant Terrace and the Bayon Temple, famed for its four massive stone-carved faces of a Bodhisattva.

Mid-Morning Angkor Wat

Following breakfast at the hotel, transfer to Angkor Wat to explore this magnificent temple complex, also known as “the city which is a temple.” Angkor Wat is the world's largest religious structure built from stone. Visit Ta Prohm, which is known for the massive trees that have engulfed the temple walls over the centuries. You also visit the Elephant Terrace and the Bayon Temple, famed for its four massive stone-carved faces of a Bodhisattva.

Afternoon Touring

This afternoon, you will have lunch at the hotel before departing for your afternoon sightseeing options.

Floating Villages on Tonle Sap

Transfer to Tonle Sap, Asia's largest freshwater lake that is home to over one hundred floating villages. Explore the floating villages by boat, getting a glimpse into the unique daily life of the local people.

Satcha Handicraft School & Siem Reap Market

Visit Satcha Handicraft School, where local Cambodian artisans are nurtured to create traditional crafts that preserve Cambodia's heritage and build a stable economic future. After, return to Siem Reap to stroll through the bustling market where locals sell clothing, spices, housewares, fresh food and handicrafts.

Apopo Hero Rat & Siem Reap Market

Embark on a visit to the Apopo Visitors Center to learn about the remarkable Hero Rat. Learn how the highly developed sense of smell of these skilled rodents makes them ideal detectors of landmines and aid tuberculosis efforts in local clinics. Afterwards, return to Siem Reap to explore the bustling market where locals sell clothing, spices, housewares, fresh food and handicrafts.

Countryside Vespa Tour

Hop on the back of a Vespa to enjoy a leisurely afternoon tour of the countryside. A guide will take you past palm-filled pastures and wetlands teeming with lotus blooms. Stop to visit a Buddhist temple and meet with monks for a blessing. You will continue to a rural village to meet the residents before returning to the hotel.

Explore Preah Dak, where you will see palm sugar production and have the opportunity to buy handmade products and stroll through the village. Return to the hotel for lunch.

Royal Khmer Cooking Class

Meet a local chef in the hotel lobby to begin your culinary adventure. You will learn how to make a local dish following a hands-on demo at the Restaurant Le Grand. After sharpening your cooking skills, you will enjoy the fruits of your labor for lunch.

Apopo Hero Rat & Siem Reap Market

Embark on a visit to the Apopo Visitors Center to learn about the remarkable Hero Rat. Learn how the highly developed sense of smell of these skilled rodents makes them ideal detectors of landmines and aid tuberculosis efforts in local clinics. Afterwards, return to Siem Reap to explore the bustling market where locals sell clothing, spices, housewares, fresh food and handicrafts.

Elephants in Kulan Forests

A one-hour drive brings you to the elephant reserve, a forest of over 1,100 protected acres in the foothills of the Kulen Mountains. Your ranger guide will tell you about the past lives of these magnificent creatures and you will follow the elephants through their natural habitat along a circular path and observe their relationships and behaviors.

Afternoon Touring

In the afternoon, choose from the following sightseeing options:

Floating Villages on Tonle Sap

Transfer to Tonle Sap, Asia's largest freshwater lake that is home to over one hundred floating villages. Explore the floating villages by boat, getting a glimpse into the unique daily life of the local people.

Satcha Handicraft School & Siem Reap Market

Visit Satcha Handicraft School, where local Cambodian artisans are nurtured to create traditional crafts that preserve Cambodia's heritage and build a stable economic future. After, return to Siem Reap to stroll through the bustling market where locals sell clothing, spices, housewares, fresh food and handicrafts.

☐ Countryside Vespa Tour

Hop on the back of a Vespa to enjoy a leisurely afternoon tour of the countryside. A guide will take you past palm-filled pastures and wetlands teeming with lotus blooms. 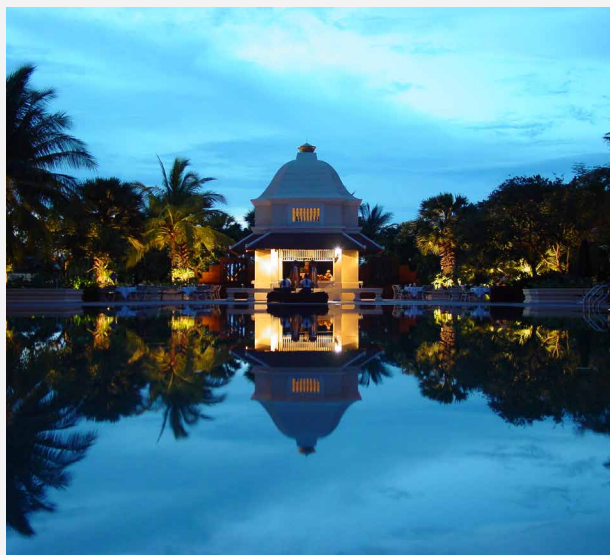
☐ Siem Reap Vespa Food Tour

Visit the 16th-century, walled city of Fatehpur Sikri. View the red sandstone buildings built by Emperor Akbar that make up the former capital of the Mogul Empire. Admire the Pre-Islamic, Hindu & Jain architectural influences and see Jama Masjid, one of largest mosques in India.

Taj Mahal

Start your morning at 8:30 a.m. with a visit to India's architectural masterpiece, the Taj Mahal. Transfer to the grand marble mausoleum, which was built for Mumtaz Mahal by her grieving widower, Emperor Shah Jahan. A guide will take you through the gardens, where pools perfectly reflect the gleaming façade. After time to take in the spectacular exterior, step into the mausoleum to see the delicately-tiled, domed interior.

Afternoon Touring

Return to the hotel for lunch. This afternoon, choose from the following sightseeing options, or remain at the hotel and relax.

Agra Fort

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage site that was home to the emperors of the Mughal Dynasty. The double-walled, sandstone fort built in 1565 A.D. by emperor Akbar features a lavishly decorated hall and tiny gem mosque as well as a mini palace.

I'timad-ud-Daulah and Kachhpura Village

Visit the Tomb of I'timad-ud-Daulah, a charming mausoleum often referred to as the "Baby Taj." This grand display of Mughal architecture was commissioned by Empress Nur Jahan for her beloved father, Mirza Ghiyas Beg, and predates the Taj Mahal by five years. Head to Kachhpura village to learn about local life and culture.

Shopping

A guide will take you to a marble factory and store, and Kohinoor Jewelers where you can shop for museum quality tapestries. A shuttle will run regularly to the hotel, allowing you to conclude your outing when you desire.

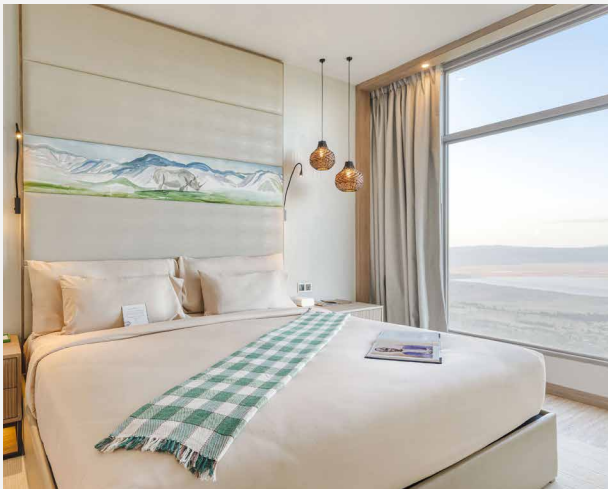

Cross over to the west bank by motorboat and board *dahabiyahs* (two-sailed passenger boats) for a river cruise. Sail through the waters of the Nile, taking in views of Luxor's ancient monuments that rise from the banks of the river and enjoying lunch on board. Return to the hotel via motorboat and enjoy time at leisure after lunch.
